WEIGH-IN

Weight control on the days 11-12.03.2016 (Friday and Saturday) at 16:00 – 19:00 in the competition venue, and the unofficial weigh-in will take place on 12-13.03.2016 (Saturday and Sunday) between 6:30-7:30 also in the competition venue.

Weight official:

U11 / U13 – 11.03.2016 (Friday) 19.00–20.00 and 12.03.2016 (Saturday) 7.30–9.00 (competitor puts out only once on the weight of chosen time)

U15 / U18 / STUDENTS - 13.03.2016 (Sunday) 7.30– 9.00

The athlete shall weigh-in wearing underclothing (men/boys – underpants, women/girls – underpants and bra), under the supervision of a weigh-in official. The removal of underclothing is not permitted. An additional 100 grams will be allowed to compensate for this. Each athlete shall bring to the weigh-in his/her accreditation card, an official identification document with photo as well as a valid medical permission. The athlete shall present all documents to the official, who will verify the identity of the athlete.

RULES FOR REFEREEING

- In the category: U11/U13 – prohibition of SHIME WAZA and KANSETSU WAZA.
- In other categories, if fighter does not give up in SHIME WAZA and loses consciousness, will not continue in the tournament.
- Additionally, in the category U11 - non-performing throws from his knees and without a handle sleeve or arm.

JUDO GI

- The first contestant called shall wear white judogi, the second contestant shall wear blue judogi (or white judogi with red belt).
- Judogi inspection is carried out in accordance with Sokuteiki rules.
- During the Award Ceremony athletes shall all wear white judogi.

ACCOMMODATION

40 PLN / person per night (Dormitory of the School of Business and Economics – 700 m away from the competition venue). We have only 180 beds.

OTHER INFORMATION

- All competitors shall have valid health insurance. Participating clubs are responsible for providing the insurance for their competitors.
- Competitors are obliged to have a valid medical permission for combat sports trainings and competitions. Coaches of participating clubs are responsible for correctness of the medical permissions.
- Organizer will not be held liable for any accidents during the tournament!
- Decoration ceremonies will take place after the fighting is finished in all age categories.
- All participating coaches shall respect the rules of behaviour and outfit (according to “Code to Conduct for Judo Coaches” and rules of “Dress Code”):
